

# Margaret Mead Elementary Mustang Report

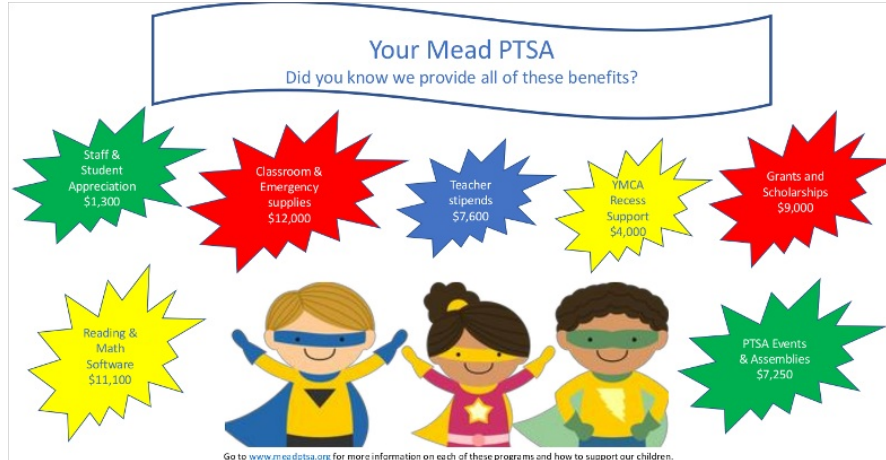

**Current chair roles needed:**

- Birthday book club co-chair - Can be administrative support from home or in the library with Sarah Jensen

- Financial Review (accounting background is ideal for this) - assists twice per year with a team, great for doing on your schedule from home. We have a chair now, but we are looking for the team!
- Gingerbread house decorating - one event, usually in December
- Ice cream social - crowd pleasing start of year social, where teachers serve the ice cream.
- Leap day coordinator - arrange an event for families to join in with on this day off school
- Lunch help coordinator - recruit and organize volunteers to assist at lunch time, can be done from home, but plan to assist in the lunch room where possible
- Science/math night - held on alternate years. Fun math games for math night and science fair for science night where kids are encouraged to contribute their own projects.
- Scholarship basket co-chair - Create a themed basket for the Mead PTSA to raffle off at the LWSD raffle. PTSA funds available.
- Special needs - Special Needs Liaison provides information to students and staff regarding disabilities. Responsibilities include coordinate Speaker for Disabilities Awareness Month (October), coordinate Disabilities Awareness Fair (every 2 years) for students in grades 3-5 (October), forward monthly meeting announcements from LWSD Special Needs Liaison to PTSA Communication chair, provides welcome letter to parents of children receiving IEP/504 services with letter (September), develop and posts bulletin board regarding disabilities monthly.
